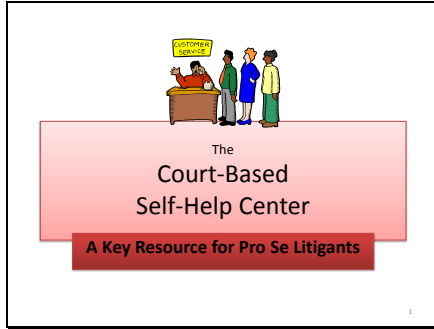


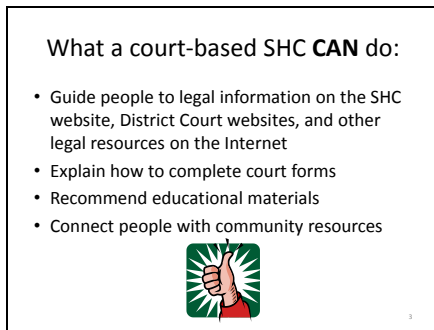

- Offer legal strategies





 - Dakota County: "Family Court Self-Help Center"





 - From other phones, call 651-259-3888.

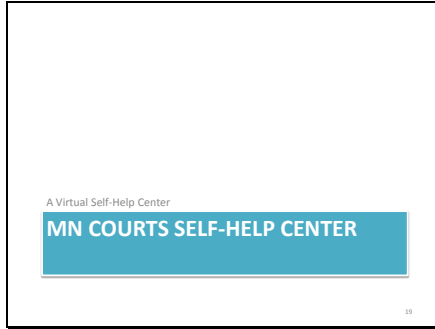

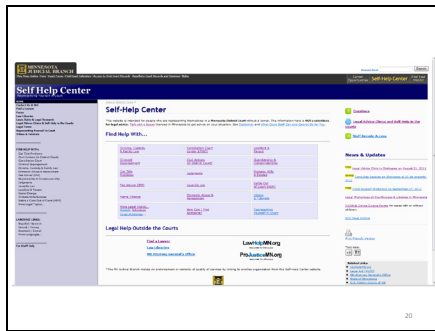

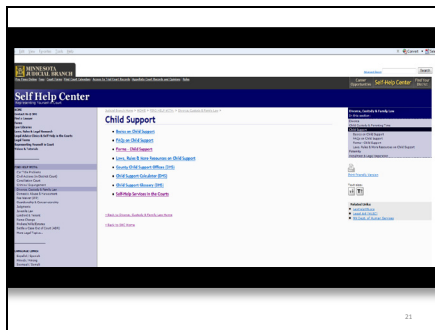
