INTRODUCTION TO BLUEZONE SCRIPTS

- BlueZone software helps users connect to PRISM
- Scripts are small code-strings or extensions
- Scripts automate repetitive, simple tasks:
 - Processing worklists
 - Adding/updating PRISM panels
 - Generating complex DORD documents
 - Started in counties
 - Note: MAXIS has used BlueZone Scripts (BZS) since 2014

CSD's BLUEZONE SCRIPTS PROJECT

- Counties requested collaborative development, testing, and verification of scripts
 - Better policy check
 - Uniformity and compliance
 - More creativity
 - Proven with MAXIS
- Goal: Start a PRISM collaborative—led by Veronica Cary
- Goal: Work with MAXIS coordinator—back-up each other




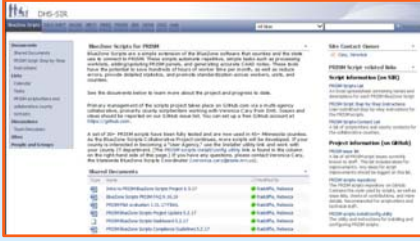
GETTING STARTED

- Discovery: Met with counties to identify needs
- Planning: Created "Roadmap" to guide project work
- Launch:
 1. Set up infrastructure
 2. Schedule hackathons
 3. Review existing ~80 scripts
 4. Create "step-by-step" instructions
- Pilot:
 1. Create Installer
 2. Recruit Counties




1st: BUILD THE INFRASTRUCTURE

- BZS tab on DHS SIR (this PPT is there!)
 - Documents
 - Announcements
 - Installer Link
 - Scripts List
 - Power Pad


INFRASTRUCTURE: GitHub



- GitHub (GH): Collaborative Cloud-Based Space*
 - Sign in—member of DHS scriptwriting team
 - Store work—in progress & completed
 - Uniform procedures (results = policy compliance)
 - Creative minds work together

GitHub FEATURES*



- GitHub: scriptwriting easier & more fun
 - Issues List—track ideas and progress
 - Functions Library—commonly used coding strings
 - Change Log—tracks changes as a script develops
 - Change Log Master List—all changes for all scripts

HACKATHONS: WORKING TOGETHER



- Hackathons: scriptwriters meet together 1/month
 - First Tasks:
 - Reviewed 87 scripts (duplication, errors, policy) →
 - 30 verified scripts
 - Accessible "step-by-step" instructions for each (template)
 - Uniform naming convention
 - Continuous Improvement each meeting—review issues/enhancements
- Testimonial? Hack = "modify creatively"*

BLUEZONE SCRIPTS PILOT

- Announced at MFSRC 2016—enthusiastic response
- Prerequisites:
 - Set of 30 verified scripts with "step-by-step" instructions
 - Power Pad tool for individual computers (build & test)
 - Installer ready—protocol for county IT to follow—link on SIR
- Goals:
 - Test installer protocol
 - Identify problems & solve
 - Small set of counties first, then expand
- User Agency Pilot : Oct 2016 through Jan 2017



BECOMING A USER AGENCY

- **BZS—Child Support Officers, Specialists, Case Aides**
- **User Counties IT departments “install” BZS**
- **Users get a “Power Pad” feature on their computer to choose script options**
- **Receive the 30 tested, verified, and compliant scripts**

PILOT: LESSONS & RESULTS

- Before pilot, 6 “fully deployed” (all users) agencies
 - Plus another 6 using scripts
- 31 counties requested to join pilot

Outcome 1/31:

New Fully Deployed Agencies	5
New Agencies 1+ User	6
Agencies Request Link-- No Reported Results	15
TOTAL COUNTIES W/ SCRIPTS	38

(Continued onboarding since then)

PILOT RESULTS: SUCCESS FACTORS

- Managers and staff excited about the potential of PRISM scripts
- Positive experience with MAXIS scripts
- Dedicated time to deploy and learn
- IT support for the process

PILOT: RESULTS & LESSONS



- Issues Tracked on Issues List:
65 issues: 37 resolved

17	BUGS- Problems with programming
6	New Script Ideas
19	Enhancement Requests
9	Housekeeping Issues (rename, comment, etc.)

Scriptwriting!

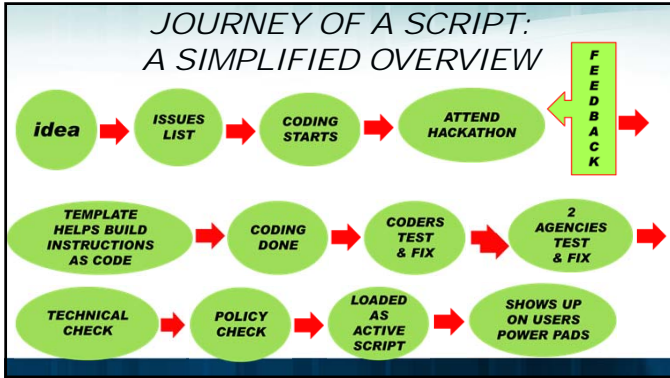
Currently, about 30 dedicated people statewide

DEVELOPING SCRIPTS

- Ideal: 1 day/week work on scripts; 1 day/mo at hackathon
 - Code scripts
 - Learn new skills/practice
 - Get feedback/help from other scriptwriters
 - Help test new scripts
 - Update instructions
 - Discuss policy implications
 - Coordinate testing at User Agencies
 - Collaborate on ideas to improve scripts
 - Ideas for new scripts



- Vision: A growing set of scripts useful to all counties



MAKING SURE IT'S RIGHT: COMPLIANCE & CI

- Scripts go through a rigorous development, evaluation, and compliance process
- BZS Coordinator considers policy fit for every new script idea
- CSD Help Desk has designated Scripts Reviewer
 - Notified regarding new script ideas
 - Reviews "step-by-step" instructions against policy
 - Tests actions of scripts
 - Requests policy review with CSD if necessary
 - Any script requiring policy review goes on "hold" until cleared

- *or*
- "Intro to Programming" at CodeCademy
(Do you like it? Have natural ability?)
- *then*
- Self-Study Training—need Supervisor approval
 - Nov 1 launch date for training
 - Approval form on DHS SIR
 - Need time (1 day a week) to code & time (1/mo) to come to hackathons

WHERE ARE WE GOING?



- Windows 10 fix
- Sign-off protocol fix
- Launch self-study training
- Review scripts in pipeline
- DHS Hackathon 1/month
- 3 WebEx coding Q/A / mo
- Notifier
- "Hover" updates
- Code-checker for code review
- Expand script set
- All/most counties use scripts
- Coordinate with MAXIS
- Install guidelines
