- Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act has been revised
 - $\circ\;$ State and local government digital content
 - $\circ~$ Must follow Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 $\,$
 - o By April 24, 2026 (* some exceptions)
- WCAG 2.1
 - Descriptions for pictures
 Captions for recordings

 - Simple layout
 - o Text and background color distinguishable
 - o Text can be resized without losing content
 - o Navigation without a mouse
 - o Dos and Don't of using tables
 - Converting word documents to PDFs
